**Incident:** UPDATED PRESS RELEASE to HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION / VICTIM IDENTIFICATION

On 01/22/2019 at approximately 8:03PM, Officers of the Monroe Police Department were dispatched to gunshots fired in the 300Blk. of Kentucky Ave. Upon arrival, both an adult female and male victim were located, both sustaining gunshot wounds. Lifesaving measures were performed on the male subject; however, he succumbed to his injuries and died. The female victim was transported to a nearby area hospital for treatment for non-life threatening injuries.

As of 01/24/2019, the female victim is expected to recover from her injuries. At this time, the shooter has not been apprehended. For protective measures, the name of the female victim is not being released at this time. The male victim in this case was identified as Gregory Thomas James, 38 years old. Detectives have notified next of kin.
