**Incident:** Breaking & Entering

Shortly after 06:00 hours this morning, the Monroe Police Department responded to an alarm at the Foodtown Pharmacy store on N Telegraph Rd. Officers arrived to find the front doors forced open, but the suspect(s) had already left the area.

The suspects solely targeted the pharmaceuticals, but as of now, nothing appears to be missing. It is believed that a secondary audible alarm may have caused the suspects to flee before they were able to get what they were looking for.
