Incident: Hit & Run Personal Injury Accident

On 09-09-2019, at approximately 8:00 pm, Officer Kleinert of the Monroe Police Department was dispatched to a personal injury accident at 1002 East Third Street. Officer Kleinert met with a victim who advised he was struck by a tan colored, late model, four-door vehicle while riding his bike in the public alleyway. The victim sustained non-life threatening injuries and was transported to Pro Medica-Monroe by medical personnel.
