**Incident:** Hit/Skip Personal Injury Accident UPDATE

On 09/09/2019, The Monroe Police Department responded to a personal injury accident at 1002 East Third Street. Upon arrival, Officer Kleinert met with the male victim (50yrs old), who advised he was struck by a tan colored, four door vehicle while riding his bike in the public alleyway. The victim sustained non-life threatening injuries and was later transported to Promedica Monroe Regional Hospital for medical treatment. The suspect vehicle and driver, fled the scene prior to police arrival.

On 09/10/2019 at approximately 8:00pm, Officer Kleinert was able to locate the offending vehicle and identify the driver (17yr old female), who was cooperative with the investigation. The names of the victim and suspect are being withheld at this time. This case has been forwarded to the Monroe County Prosecutor's Office.
