Incident: On 09/17/19 at approximately 2:40AM, the Monroe Police Department responded to the area of W. 5th St and Cass St in regards to several gunshots being fired in the area. Upon arrival, Officers discovered a female subject that had suffered a single gunshot wound. The female subject was treated on scene by the Monroe Fire Department and Monroe County Ambulance personnel. The subject was transported to St. Vincents hospital for treatment for a non life threatening gunshot wound.

Witnesses advised the suspect was an unknown black male, with dreadlocks, wearing grey sweatpants and a black hooded sweatshirt. The suspect was last observed riding a bicycle West bound on W. 5th St. Officers from the Monroe Police Department and the Monroe County Sheriff Department searched the area for the suspect, without success.
