On 09/19/2019, The Monroe Police Department investigated a shooting in the 500 block of Cass St. The investigation identified Cornelius Delvontae Aaron-Woody as the suspect in this case. As a result, an arrest warrant was issued for Mr. Aaron-Woody.

On 10/31/2019 at approximately 11:15AM, the Monroe Police Department received information that Mr. Aaron-Woody was arrested by the U.S. Marshal Service in Roanoke, Virginia, where he is currently being held, pending extradition to Michigan. Mr. Aaron-Woody is facing multiple felony charges, including Attempted Homicide and Weapon Offenses. The Monroe Police Department would like to thank the U.S. Marshal Service for their cooperation and assistance in the location and apprehension of Mr. Aaron-Woody.
