Incident: Home Invasion / Felonious Assault

On October 18, 2020 at approximately 11:55PM, The Monroe Police Department responded to the 700Blk. Of E. Third St. on reports of a Weapons / Shots Fired complaint. Officers arrived and began investigating, to discover that a 25 year old male suspect forced his way into a residence, then threatened the 31 year old male victim, while brandishing a handgun. Investigation revealed the two subjects engaging into a physical altercation, where two shots were fired inside the residence.

The victim eventually forced the suspect outside of the residence, at which point, the physical altercation continued. While outside the residence, the suspect turned and fired one shot at the victim. Witnesses were located and confirm this information. There were no reported injuries resulting from this serious incident. The suspect fled the location upon shooting at the victim.

In this case, a person of interest has been identified as Anthony Deshawn Nicholson-Dortch Jr. The Monroe Police Department Detective Bureau is actively investigating this case and are seeking to speak with Mr. Nicholson-Dortch at this time. Anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of Mr. Nicholson-Dortch Jr. are encouraged to contact the Monroe Police Detective Bureau.
