Incident: Investigation of Shooting

On 01/02/20 at approximately 3:25 pm, the Monroe Police Department responded to the Valero Gas Station at 629 S. Monroe St. for a report of a shooting with one person shot. Officers located one male victim in the parking lot with a gun shot wound and quickly determined that the suspect had already fled the scene in a vehicle. Officers tended to the victim's injuries until medical personnel from the Monroe Fire Department and Monroe Community Ambulance arrived on scene. The victim was transported to an area hospital by Monroe Community Ambulance and is listed in stable condition.

The suspect is a black male, approximately 20-30 years old, smaller build, with black hair and wearing all dark clothing. The suspect vehicle is described as a light silver Cadillac four door with tinted windows. The suspect is considered to be armed and dangerous. This is an active and on-going investigation.
