Incident: Armed Robbery / Suspect Update - SUSPECT IN CUSTODY

On 04/19/21, the Monroe Police Department had reported several armed robberies. The investigation revealed Trealajonte Tigney as the suspect. An informational BOL was released to the public through the media, requesting assistance in locating Mr. Tigney, as his whereabouts at the time were unknown. Arrest warrants were issued for Mr. Tigney and information was gathered, which lead Officers to a Monroe Township home. Mr. Tigney was located inside the home and was taken into custody without incident on 04/23/21. Mr. Tigney was lodged in the Monroe County Jail and was arraigned today in the 1st District Court of Monroe on multiple charges, where bond was set at \$450,000.00 with future court dates scheduled.
