PARKS & RECREATION SURVEY CURRENTLY UNDERWAY

Monroe, Michigan – The City of Monroe Parks and Recreation Department is seeking community feedback as they update their 5-year master plan for programming and parks. A survey has been developed to gather resident responses which will help future recreation programs and parks facilities planning.

Survey questions include park usage, programs currently used or those one would like to see offered, and any suggestions for improvements. Answers will remain anonymous.
